Please join us for the 21st USS Soley (DD 707) Reunion. Whether this will be your 1st reunion, your 21st or somewhere in-between, sign up now to renew old Soley friendships, make new Soley friends, share sea stories, take some great tours, or just hang out. You can come for as many or as few days that you choose to; and you can attend all, some, or none of the tours and events.

This might be our last reunion, so you don't want to miss it!!

Our host hotel is just across the Potomac River from our Nation's Capital in historic Old Town Alexandria, VA., where many of our founding fathers had townhomes or were frequent visitors to this quaint riverfront town. George Washington's Mount Vernon is just a few miles down-river.

Family members and friends are welcome. We encourage you to have your loved ones and special friends join us, as many have in the past. Just provide them a copy of this registration packet so that they can register.

A description of all scheduled Reunion tours and events is included with this letter along with an Event Registration Form. Please take a few minutes to read through this material, and after you see what we have planned, you will be ready to sign up.

HOTEL GROUP ROOM RATE: \$160.16 per night, including all taxes and fees, a full buffet breakfast each day (no more than 2 per room), and complimentary garage parking (normally \$20 daily). The group rate is valid 3 days prior to and 3 days following the reunion, based on room availability. Handicap accessible rooms are available.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Because the room rate is higher than we have paid in the past, the Reunion Association will be reimbursing everyone registered at the hotel a cash rebate of \$20 for each night you are staying at the hotel, but only for the 5-day reunion period, 1-5 November. There will be no rebate for any nights you choose to stay before or after the reunion. The rebate will be provided at the Reunion.

All guest accommodations are two room suites, with separate sleeping and living areas, two 32" TV's, a small refrigerator, microwave, and coffee maker. Free wi-fi service is provided in each suite.

There is complimentary hotel shuttle service to and from Ronald Reagan National Airport (DCA), which is only 2 miles away. The shuttle is also available in the afternoons and evenings to and from the historic Old Town waterfront, restaurants, and entertainment – only 6 walking blocks from the hotel. There is a full-service restaurant and bar in the hotel, and a Harris Teeter grocery store across the street. There are also numerous restaurants within walking distance of the hotel.

EVERYONE STAYING AT THE HOTEL MUST MAKE THEIR OWN ROOM RESERVATIONS

Making room reservations has some different “wrinkles” than for previous reunions. Please read the “Enclosure” following this letter that explains how to book your hotel room.

PLEASE, COMPLETE THE ATTACHED REUNION REGISTRATION FORM AND MAIL IT, ALONG WITH YOUR CHECK, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE! Your Reunion Committee has expenses that must be paid prior to the reunion including payments to our hotel and tour company.

Your completed form and check should be returned to me, your Reunion Coordinator. My address is printed at the bottom of the enclosed Registration Form.

Be one of the first 25 to submit your Registration Form and you will be entered into a special drawing at our Grand Banquet for free lodging. There will be three drawings: One for 1 night's lodging; one for 2 night's lodging; and one for 3 night's lodging. The winners will receive checks from our Treasurer the evening of the Banquet. You must be a registered guest at the hotel to be eligible for the drawing.

There will be a 50/50 drawing and a raffle of donated items at the Banquet. **THERE WILL BE NO DOOR PRIZES THIS YEAR** as it is too time-consuming, and as we get older, most of us don't need more “stuff.” **DO NOT BRING ITEMS FOR DOOR PRIZES.**

You will be able to purchase tickets for the raffle and 50/50 drawings throughout the reunion. If you have items to donate as raffle items please bring them; but do not bring large items that winners cannot take home on an airplane. Gift cards are welcome! Remember, proceeds from the drawings help keep the Association solvent. All donations are very much appreciated.

Ship's Store: A Ship's Store Order Form is posted on the USS Soley website (www.USSSoley.org) for those who want to make purchases prior to their arrival at the reunion. You must mail your order to our Storekeeper, Patty Kranack, by the 3rd week in September to insure that you receive your merchandise prior to the Reunion.
